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#### ORDER:

Where as in accidence with the minutes of the meeting headed by the Chief Secretary to Government of Andhra Pradesh held on 11th march 2022 on convergence of Skilling Activities. It has been proposed to create a model on the structure of the Skill Ecosystem at various levels, that is Assembly Constituencies, Parliamentary Constituencies in the State.

In this regard it was contemplated to converge duly integrating Skill Hubs at Assembly Constituency wise consisting of Government Polytechnic, ITIs and Skill Development Centers. Further it has been decided to study the implementation of the Skilling in all educational Institutions. Therefore it is very much necessary to deploy ESC Coordinators and Engineering Skill Trainers of APSSDC working in the field for all Assembly Constituency wise Skill Hubs has to take measures for the implementation of Skill training activities across 175 Assembly Constituencies.

Hence, it is decided to deploy 2 Training Coordinators for each Assembly Constituency Skill Hub and their Job Chart is detailed below:

1. The Assembly Constituency Skill Hub is designated as their head quarter and they should work together with the concerned Head of Institution that is Government Polytechnic/ITIs/Skill Development Centres. They should report to the Concerned Nodal Officers/DSDOs of APSSDC.

Preparation of Annual A/C Skill Development Plan (ASDP)

Conducting training programs as per ASDP

Providing placement support

Training of trainers

Dealing with training partners

Selection of the candidates with the support of Village Secretariats
