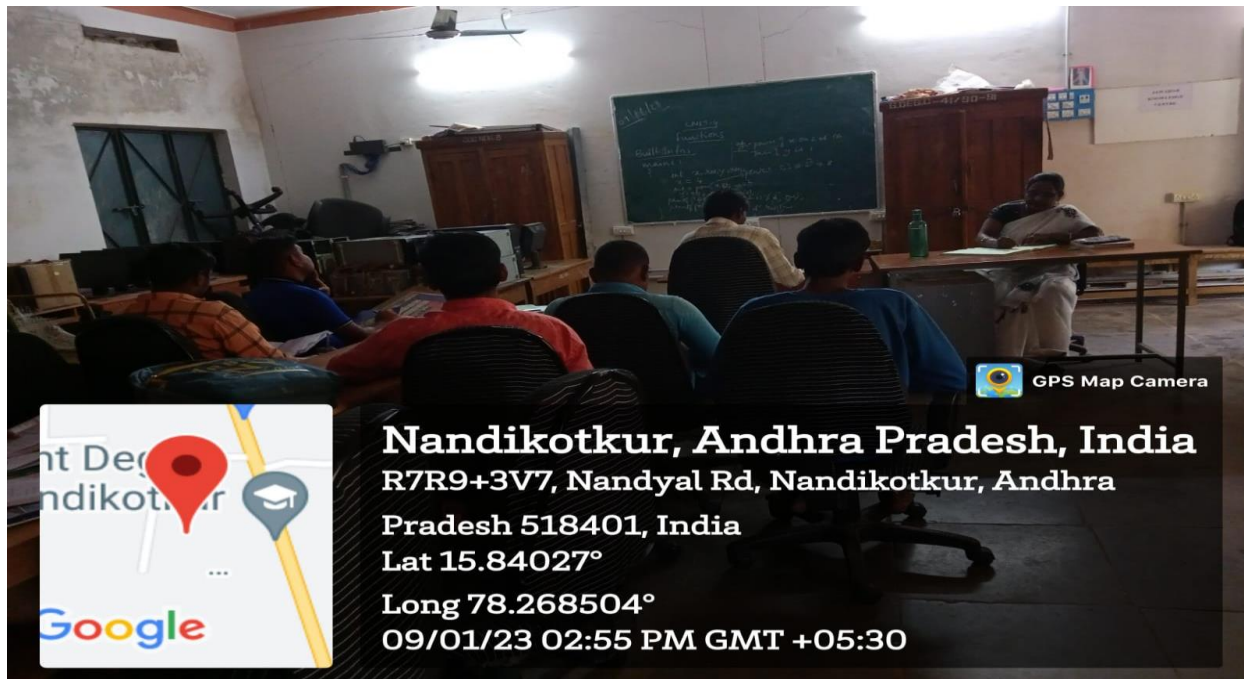

SPECIAL REPRESENTATION FOR SPECIAL CATEGORIES: 2% for Meritorious Sports Persons (MSP); 3% for NCC; 5% for Police Executive (PE); 1% for Police Ministerial (PM); 2% for Children of Police Personnel (CPP) and 2% for CDI.

ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS:

Civil Sub Inspectors: Men & Women are eligible.

APSP Reserve Sub Inspectors: only Men are eligible.

APSP Reserve Sub Inspectors:

Based on their score in the Final Written Examination (Paper-III-100 Marks, Paper-IV-100 Marks, Total 200 marks) and Physical Efficiency Test (for 100 marks), totaling to 300 marks. The Final Written Examination Paper I and II are qualifying in nature

FEE STRUCTURE: Candidates with local candidature of Andhra Pradesh, belonging to OCs and BCs, Rs. 600/- ; SCs and STs, Rs. 300/-.

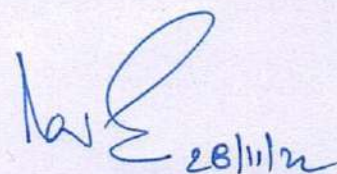

Report of the programme
