





### Scope of the webinar

Intellectual property rights (IPR) refer to the legal rights that protect the creations of the human intellect, such as inventions, literary and artistic works, symbols, names, images, and designs. IPR includes patents, trademarks, copyrights, and trade secrets. Overall, intellectual property rights play an important role in encouraging innovation and creativity by providing creators with the legal protection and financial incentives they need to continue developing new ideas and products. And Universities and public research institutions are among the direct contributors towards innovation and research, particularly in emerging economies. The potential pool of talent for innovation in these economies also emanates largely from educational institutions and research institutions. Off late, the significance of Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) in higher education has been widely recognized. This could be credited to the National IPR Policy approved by the Union Cabinet in May 2016, which was the first ever IPR policy framed by the Government of India. The primary focus of this Policy is towards promoting innovation and creativity, especially amongst entrepreneurs and in higher education institutions. The Policy brief specifically mentions synergizing all forms of IPR, concerned statutes and agencies for tapping the creativity and innovative energies in India with a special emphasis on start-ups and educational institutions.
