During this programme the Police officials demonstrated the process of App installations in individual's cells. The staff and students installed the DISHA App in their mobile Phones.



Brief Report:

Women Empowerment Cell (WEC) conducted a meeting on 14-09-2022 at 2.00 PM in the seminar hall with all girl students of the college. In this connection, the members of WEC explained the students about 1) Girls Trafficking 2) Drop-outs 3) Hygiene and usage of Napkin pads 4) Disha-App. They explained the students that usually girls are trafficked for the purpose of sexual and Economic exploitation, particularly prostitution and pornography, forced labour and domestic work etc., Students are advised not to believe anybody blindly and must be cautious. The girl students are advised not to stop education and stand on their own feet. The WEC members advised the girl students that they have to maintain hygiene and informed to take sanitary napkin pads whenever needed. Finally, the members advised the students to install Disha-App for their safety which is useful in emergency situation.
