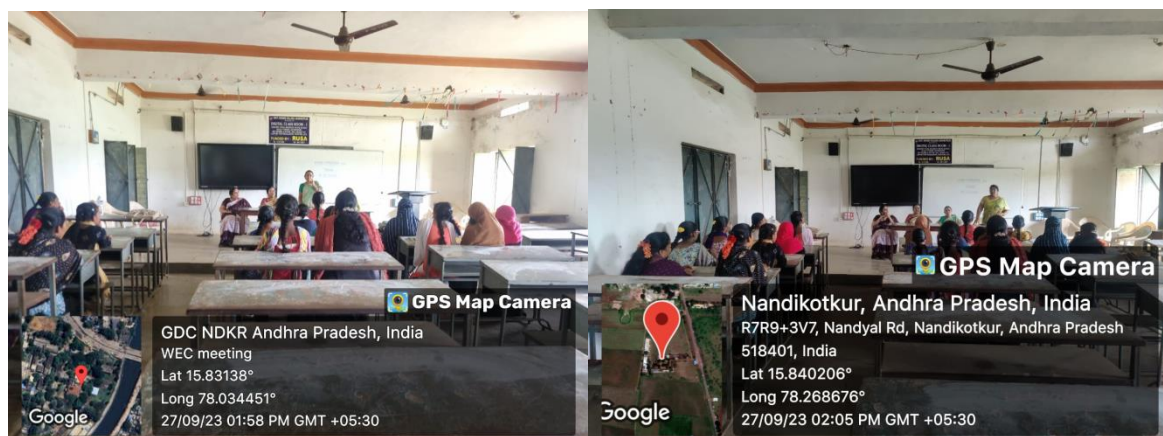


Brief Report:

Brief Report:

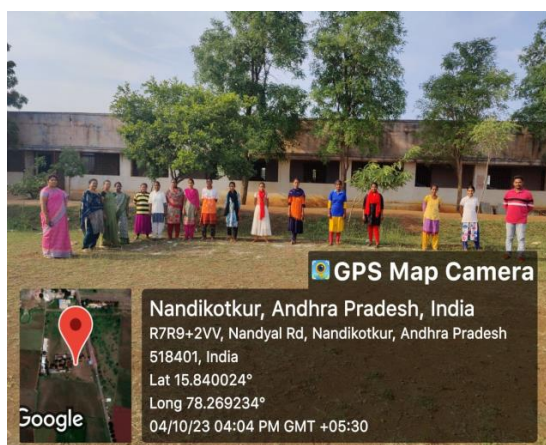

Poster Presentation on the Occasion of International Girl Child Day

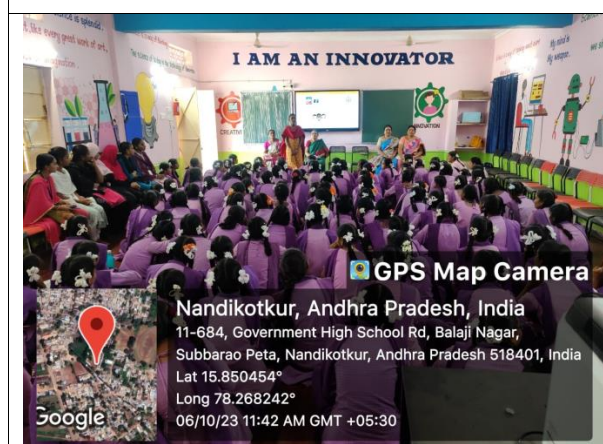
