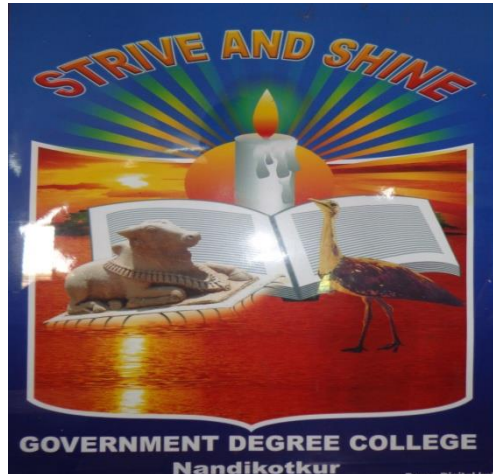

Women Empowerment Cell organized the following competitions to motivate the girl students.

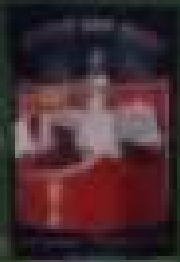

SANITARY NAPKIN INCINERATOR

The institution has placed a sanitary napkin incinerator machine in the girl's toilet room to dispose used sanitary napkins safely. Used sanitary napkins are often disposed of in dustbins or open surfaces, thereby giving rise to various contagious diseases or when disposed in toilets they block the sewage system. To overcome this common problem, a sanitary napkin incinerator machine is arranged to destroy the used napkins, thereby causing minimum harm to the environment.

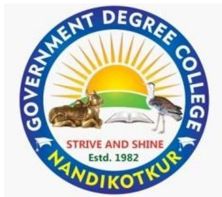

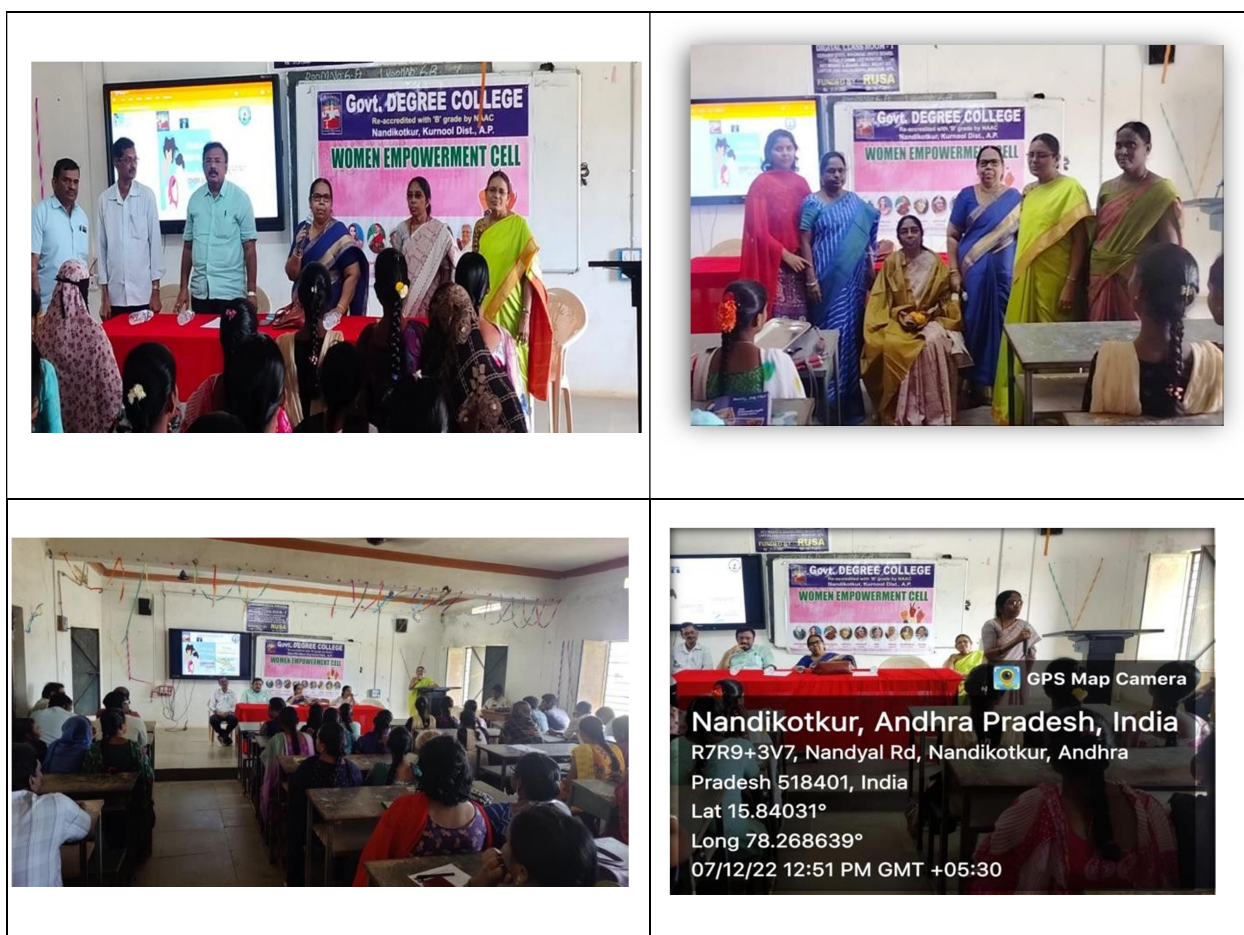


Brief Report:

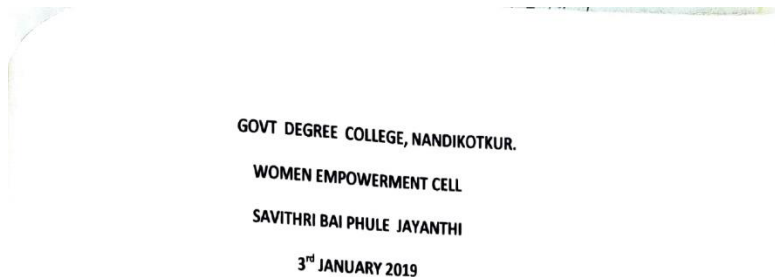


Brief Report of Day 3 ,12-02-2017
